1. Why are we holding this webinar?

This webinar is the second of two 'bridge' events between the 2020 RCE Regional Meetings and the RCE Global Conference in Autumn 2021. It will:

- Enable and sustain collaborative conversations across the RCE Network
- Launch the new Roadmap for the RCE Community 2021-2030
- Share and celebrate good practice regarding climate-related activity from across the RCE community
- Explore how we take action on the UNESCO ESD Roadmap through the 'lens' of climate-related activity as we approach COP26.

Delegates will have the opportunity to submit examples of activity from their RCE that link action on climate change with one of the Five Themes in the UNESCO ESD 2030 Roadmap. All of these examples will be shared on the <u>dedicated webinar webpage</u>. Five of these examples will be presented during the webinar.

The process for this will be:

- o RCEs wishing to submit an example of activity should indicate this on the registration form when asked.
- Examples of activity should be no more than five minutes in length and in the medium of the delegate's choice (e.g. blog, podcast, narrated slideshow, text-based narrative etc.).
